

(We will *not* be searching for a priest-in-charge whose term as such would be limited to three years). The schedule on Sunday is as follows:

- 1. *There will be one service at 10:00 am*, at which Canon Hodapp will preside and preach.
- 2. Immediately following the service, Tim and Amber will address the parish about the rector search, the steps we will need to take and the support we will get from the diocese.
- 3. Immediately following that, we will hold our annual meeting, at which time we will elect a new class for the vestry, among other business. A light lunch will be served in the Parish Hall once the meeting has adjourned.


